

ABB Power Technology Medium Voltage to Increase Distribution Component Pricing

ABB announces a new price increase for Distribution Components manufactured in Greensboro, NC.

As of April 1, 2006, ABB, the leading power and automation technology group, stated that it will raise prices on distribution cutouts and single phase switches 4-7% based on specific raw material and transportation cost impacts. These adjustments are a direct result of significant cost escalation of raw materials seen in the industry.

Customers will be notified separately of the specific impact to them. The price increase became effective on all quotations starting April 1, 2006.
